The audio player embedded in the website will allow you to hear your part, adjusting right/left controls (your part vs. the other voice parts) and speed.

**NEW Player Controls**

100 0  
Speed Balance

Play, stop, beginning and next buttons

Lower/raise the "speed" number to slow down or speed up the track

Any Value Between -100 and 100  
-100 = Left (full parts only)  
-50 = Half Left  
0 = Center  
50 = Half Right  
100 = Right (Your Part Only)

All the pieces from the oratorio are listed in order. To hear your part, **ADJUST speed and balance first**, then click your voice part on the right side of the table. If you need to adjust the speed or balance after beginning a track, enter the new number, then click the song title again.
